Most of the housings can be ordered as "IV" (Inverted assemblies). The inverted (or upside down) housings are arranged so that all ports, including the drain connection are in the head. This allows the filter element to be serviced without disconnecting any fittings.

The element is kept in the correct vertical position to allow proper liquid drainage. Other head ported drain assemblies typically are horizontally mounted which does not drain as quickly and can lead to high downstream carry-over.

Inverted housings may be ordered with (example IV112) or without (example IV116) a bowl drain connection. The traditional drain bowl connection can be used as a vent or gauge port.
